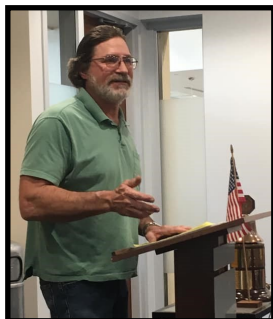
Paul received his button today, thanks for coming on board Paul!

Our speaker today was Mr. Joe Schalasky from Seton Harvest. Joe is the Farm Manager at Seton Harvest which was started in 2006 and located at 9400 New Harmony Road, Evansville, IN. Seton Harvest is a ministry of the Daughters of Charity that uses their 10 acres of ground in a just and environmentally conscious way by sharing locally grown food with shareholders and donating 25% of the produce to charities each year. Seton Harvest averages 150 shareholders each year, they grow 50-60 different vegetables each year. The season lasts 26 weeks and the crops are organic. Each year they provide educational field days to over 800 children. The cost to purchase a share is \$675 for a full share or \$475 for a partial share. Seton Harvest is a non-profit organization and is owned by the Daughters of Charity.
