Over 3 million American have epilepsy and roughly 181,000 new cases of seizures and epilepsy occur each year. There are two types of seizures. Generalized with involve the whole brain and loss of consciousness and Partial seizures that involve only one part of the brain. May or may not include loss of consciousness.

First Aid for Complex Partial Seizures include staying calm and track the time. Do not restrain the person. Remove dangerous objects from the person’s path. Remain with the person until he or she is fully alert. Call an ambulance if the seizure lasts longer than 5 minutes.

He talked about some of the causes. 70% of the people with epilepsy do not know the cause. In the remaining 30%, the most common causes are; Head trauma, brain tumor and stroke, lead poisoning, infection of the brain tissue, heredity, and prenatal disturbance of brain development.
