






- John reminded members of our upcoming picnic on Saturday, June 16th at Scott **Township Park**. More details to follow.

Ed Harrison Memorial **Golf Scramble** 








Sarge Josh Paulson took conscience money from several members then went into his trivia questions for members. Most tables were losers except for one table with trivia savvy members.

New member, Tanya Merkel introduced our speaker this week, Eric Smith, Executive Director, of Big Brothers, Big Sisters. Eric has become Director giving up another position in marketing and advertising because he felt he needed to make more of a contribution to help kids.

He gave us an overview of the organization which helps over 300 kids annually. At Big Brothers Big Sister, they match carefully screen volunteers (Bigs") with children facing adversity ("littles") in one-to -one relationships. Men and Women who want to be mentors apply to the program. accepted they are placed with a boy or girl and become a person who spends time with them in place of their dad or mother figure. They take the kids to various activities in which many of them have never participated. These are caring adults, a friend, listener, to be there for the child. 80% of the kids improve in class work, as well as increasing self-worth.



Eric related a story of two individuals, Justin the mentor and Chris the "little". Over a period of 5 years they did countless activities together and help Chris grow into a better young man.

Facts Chris shared: 78% of children in EVSC are on free lunch; 55% lives with a single parent or grandparents.; 11% have an incarcerated parent; Vanderburgh County poverty level is 25%. There are over 200 kids on their waiting list who need a mentor.
