Tim introduced the guest speaker (and daughter), Candace Chapman, Director of Downtown Development for E-REP. She gave an overview of their activities since 2016 –

- Created the Economic Improvement District
- 460 housing units have been added
- 495 hotel rooms built
- 44 shops and restaurants added with 5 under construction
- Reduced commercial vacant square feet downtown by 42%
- Built Mickey's Kingdom
- Skatepark will break ground this spring
- LST relocation
- Public space improvements: Walnut Street Connector stretching from Vann to 4th St., Post House Park, Self.e Alley, Game Room Alley
- An active, accessible riverfront: River Vision ideation.

Candace also talked about the 5th and Main St. project which has faced obstacles from COVID, inflation and supply chain for steel that's required for the project. The project is slowly moving forward. She also shared the vision for the riverfront that needs the support of the entire community. She opened it up for Q&A which was also informative.
