Guest Speaker: Darlene "Dolly's Dynamo" Short

Our speaker, **Darlene Short**, gave a wonderful presentation about the **Warrick Literacy and Education Connections** (WLEC). Founded in 1995 with the help of Dolly Parton (yes, *that* Dolly), the program helps get books into the hands of young readers through **Dolly Parton's Imagination Library**.

They currently serve **2,100+ children every month** in Warrick County! That's a lot of bedtime stories and not a single overdue fine.

Darlene shared stories of local pre-teens raising money years ago to keep the program alive—proof that Optimism and Generosity have no age limits. Their dream is to build a self-sustaining Foundation with **\$750,000**, and we have no doubt they'll get there.

She reminded us that reading to children under age five is not just sweet—it's *critical*. It helps wire their little brains for reading success. So read *Goodnight Moon* like your life depends on it!
