

Their Foundation has built 23 homes internationally since 2015 and provide affordable housing opportunities on a global scale. In addition they are supporting this work in our own communities here at home. What does it mean to own a home? It means meeting personal and financial goals. It means building lasting memories and strong community relationships. It means investing in the future. Their guiding philosophy is that **WE ARE ONE**. The JD Sheth Foundation is a project to project organization focusing on the education, health, and well being of others, specifically children and the elderly, here in the United States and across the globe. She also explained that no more that 10% goes to administration and expenses. The rest of the money goes to the projects.
