Our speaker today was courtesy of Mark Hackert. Mark introduced Republican Mayoral Candidate., Lloyd Winnecke.

Lloyd discussed all of the many positive construction and activities happening right now in Evansville. First he said that this is the best job he has ever had.







First, he discussed the new **Downtown hotel** with 240 rooms...opening Fall 2016. It will add to the tax rolls and will help spur economic development in Downtown Evansville. It will help the ONB Events Plaza by bringing more conventions to Evansville. Lloyd also updated us about the **IU Medical Center** that should be open August 2017 or January 2018. USI, UE, and IU will work offer complimentary courses on campus. Next was **Tropicana** information. He said an announcement soon will announce they will be moving to land with a huge investment. **Lloyd-Highway 41 Interchange** completion is another finished project. He also talked about **Roberts Park** where 300 trees have been planted and the completed **Vann Avenue Crosswalk** across the Lloyd expressway that will connect McDonald's Golf course all the way to Lincoln Avenue.

Next Lloyd addressed the budget cuts by the City Council and how they are optimistic they can work around the cuts and still eliminate the housing blight problems. The roads budget has been cut by .8 million dollars leaving one million in that budget. He also mentioned that several not-for-profit organizations are getting cuts or losing their grants all together.

He has been working with EPA on the sewer project and which will cause many millions of dollars.
